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SECRETARIAT'S MESSAGE

A MESSAGE FROM THE SECRETARIAT

On the occasion of United Nations International Day for Dialogue among Civilizations on June 10 we reflect on the dynamic global educational collaboration over the past month or so.

The 2025 World Digital Education Conference in Wuhan from May 14 to 16, with the theme "Educational development and transformation: The intelligent era", issued the Wuhan Initiative on Digital Education Cooperation, charting a course for AI-driven educational transformation.

The ninth Shanghai Cooperation Organization Meeting of Education Ministers in Xinjiang on May 13 highlighted the principle of educational collaboration and promoting inclusiveness and mutual learning.

These events demonstrate that digital technology and civilizational dialogue have become dual engines propelling human progress.

Shandong University and Cambridge University joined to promote collaboration in innovation, and Yunnan University partnered with the University of Malaya to establish frontier institutes in AI and biomedicine, cultivating talent needed for the Belt and Road Initiative.

Xi'an International Studies University opened its first overseas branch, in Thailand, as a hub for Chinese language and culture interdisciplinary talent development. Beijing Language and Culture University and the Latin American Faculty of Social Sciences in Costa Rica affirmed education's powerful role as a bridge between the peoples of the world.

This newsletter chronicles these and many more tremendous efforts in educational collaboration. When digital technology bridges knowledge divides, and when civilizational dialogue transcends cultural barriers, education can underpin sustainable human development. We encourage all members to harness all their wisdom and knowhow as together we continue to shape education that is characterized by openness, innovation and enthusiasm in taking on the toughest challenges.

CHINA (NINGBO) - CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPEAN COUNTRIES EDUCATION COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE CONFERENCE

This year's conference, with the theme "High-quality education empowering sustainable development", was held in Ningbo, Zhejiang province, from May 23 to 25. The conference aims to explore new trends and opportunities for higher education collaboration between China and Central and Eastern European countries in the context of digitalization. The meeting included a roundtable discussion titled "Opportunities and Challenges of China-Central and Eastern European International Cooperation in the Context of Digital Transformation". It focused on the impact of digitalization on higher education development, talent cultivation and industry-education integration. Nearly 260 university leaders and representatives, government officials and experts and scholars from China and more than 10 Central and Eastern European countries took part.

WORLD DIGITAL EDUCATION CONFERENCE

This year's World Digital Education Conference, with the theme "Educational development and transformation in the age of intelligence", was held in Wuhan from May 14 to 16. The conference aims to respond to United Nations' initiatives on global educational transformation and to jointly promote the development and reform of education in the intelligent era. Attendees included representatives of education departments from many countries, heads of international organizations, principals and student-teacher representatives from schools at all levels in China and elsewhere, representatives of digital technology companies, and experts and scholars. Participants discussed technological frontiers, policy mechanisms, application promotion and digital ethics. During the conference the World Digital Education Alliance issued several major papers, including the White Paper on Smart Education in China, the 2025 Global Digital Education Development Index, Digital Education Fronts and the Wuhan Initiative on Digital Education Cooperation.

MEETING OF EDUCATION MINISTERS OF SHANGHAI COOPERATION ORGANIZATION MEMBER STATES

This meeting, the ninth, was held in Urumqi, Xinjiang, on May 13. During the meeting, representatives discussed educational reforms and strategic development initiatives undertaken since last year's meeting. They also outlined priority areas for future collaboration in education among SCO member states. All parties expressed their willingness to jointly explore models and directions for educational collaboration within the SCO framework, with the goal of enhancing people-to-people connectivity through collaboration in education.

The meeting reviewed and approved a series of initiatives and documents, including the SCO University Digital Education Development Plan, the Urumqi Initiative and a joint communique. It also marked the official establishment of the SCO National Digital Education Alliance and the China-SCO Doctoral Students Innovation Center.

INAUGURAL CHINA-CENTRAL ASIA EDUCATION MINISTERS' MEETING

It also marked the inauguration of the China-Central Asia Industry-Education Integration Alliance and the Central Asia Institute of the Global Institute for Teacher Development, and established the China-Kazakhstan Institute for Outstanding Engineers. The University Signs an Agreement with Latin American Faculty of Social Sciences

Rebecca Lemos Igreja, Secretary-General of the Latin American Faculty of Social Sciences, whose headquarters are in Costa Rica, visited the university to discuss deepening collaboration on joint high-level research and cultural exchanges between China and Latin America. The President of the university, Duan Peng, and Igreja signed an agreement. It is the university's first collaboration with the highest-level social science research institution in Latin America. The two parties will integrate think tank, research and teaching resources to advance the establishment of the Latin America and Caribbean Community (CELAC)-China Institute, jointly provide strategic counsel for building a China-Latin America and the Caribbean community with a shared future, promote multilateral cultural exchanges, strengthen academic and technological cooperation, and facilitate joint initiatives aligned with the development of China-CELAC relations.

The University Renews Agreement with the University of Cambridge

Ren Youqun, Party Committee Secretary of Shandong University, led a delegation to visit the University of Cambridge and renewed agreement with Cambridge Enterprise on May 20. The two universities began working together eight years ago by jointly establishing the School of Innovation and Entrepreneurship of Shandong University.

Under the agreement the two universities work together in innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystems to support the development of Shandong University's regional innovation ecosystem. Drawing on the resources of the University of Cambridge and Cambridge Enterprise, specialized training will be provided for Shandong University's key faculty, researchers and administrative staff. In addition they will jointly implement international talent development programs aimed at enhancing students' global perspectives and cross-cultural competencies.

The university received a delegation from Eötvös Loránd University in Hungary led by its Vice President Hamar Imre. The Vice President of Zhejiang Normal University Lin Yigang said China and Hungary are trusted friends and partners, and the strengthening of their relationship has created favorable conditions for university exchanges. The university hopes to deepen collaboration with Eötvös Loránd University in various areas, including faculty and student exchanges, joint educational programs and the development of collaborative research platforms.

Multiple Cooperative Milestones with Universities in Japan and Thailand Achieved

The first overseas branch campus of Xi'an International Studies University in Thailand was established.

Wu Yaowu, President of Xi'an International Studies University, led a delegation to Japan and Thailand to advance educational exchanges and collaboration between his university and universities in these two countries. The university and Kyoto University of Foreign Studies signed an agreement on a new program allowing undergraduate students to pursue master's degrees. The university also renewed an agreement with Reitaku University in Kashiwa, Chiba prefecture. During a visit to Rajamangala University of Technology Krungthep in Bangkok, Xi'an International Studies University established its first overseas branch campus in Thailand. It will develop international Chineselanguage programs and adopt a "Chinese + Culture" interdisciplinary talent cultivation model. By integrating core initiatives such as joint Thai-Chinese bilingual professional training and Chinese-language proficiency programs for Thais, it aims to cultivate and supply crosscultural talent proficient in Chinese and well-versed in Chinese culture for Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) and countries involved in the Belt and Road Initiative.

During the visit, Yunnan University and the University of Malaya signed an agreement on establishing the Yunnan-Malaya College of Yunnan University, a significant step in advancing international collaboration in education, scientific research and youth exchanges. The joint initiative to establish the Yunnan-Malaya College of Yunnan University has been approved by China's Ministry of Education and will begin taking enrollments this year. The college will focus on fields such as artificial intelligence, new materials, new energy and biomedicine, aiming to cultivate high-demand talent to support the Belt and Road Initiative and regional socio-economic development.

Before the event the two universities signed a faculty and student exchange agreement, a new phase in their partnership that opens a new chapter in multidisciplinary talent development and research collaboration.

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

In Moscow, Qiu Yong, Party Committee Secretary of the university, met Anatoly Torkunov, President of the Moscow State Institute of International Relations, and Kirill Dmitriev, chief executive of the Russian Direct Investment Fund, to sign agreements. The three parties will accelerate the cultivation of high-level talent by establishing joint degree programs, strengthening joint research, promoting faculty and student exchanges, and conducting talent training programs. Collaboration will also focus on collaborative development in technology, energy, agriculture, infrastructure and the digital economy. Qiu Yong also met Herman Gref, chief executive and chairman of the Savings Bank of the Russian Federation, to discuss enhancing the dual innovation engines of universities and businesses. They discussed deeper collaboration in artificial intelligence, digital finance and other fields to foster integrated innovation between industry, academia and research. A collaboration agreement was signed. The university also signed agreements with the National Research University Higher School of Economics in Russia.
