KUNMING FORUM ON SOUTH AND SOUTHEAST ASIA EDUCATION COOPERATION

The 8th China–South Asia and Southeast Asia Education Cooperation Kunming Forum was held on October 23, hosted by the Yunnan Provincial Department of Education and organized by Yunnan University. The forum, under the theme "Jointly building a high-level international education cooperation region", brought together officials from the consulates-general of various countries in Kunming, along with university presidents, experts and scholars from 13 South and Southeast Asian countries. It aimed to further advance high-level collaboration in Sino-foreign education, vocational education, digital education, faculty training and talent cultivation between China and South and Southeast Asian countries. It also sought to promote the establishment of a high-level international education cooperation region in Yunnan, contributing educational wisdom and strength to the region's economic construction and social development.

During the event, six important agreements were signed, the Lancang-Mekong Workshop project was established, two other projects were initiated, three alliances were formed, and the 2026 RCEP Youth Exchange Program was unveiled.

The second World Conference on China Studies was held in Shanghai from October 13 to 15, aiming to achieve broader consensus on advancing sinology and promote cultural exchanges between China and the rest of the world. The conference, with the theme "Historical and contemporary China in a global context", was hosted by the State Council Information Office and the Shanghai Municipal People's Government. During the event, the Shanghai Initiative on Mutual Learning Among Civilizations and the Flourishing of China Studies Worldwide was unveiled. About 500 guests from more than 50 countries and regions attended. 



Why this research matters

Artificial Intelligence is fundamentally transforming education. As technology handles more of the systematic knowledge delivery, the roles and core competencies of teachers are being intensely scrutinized globally. We believe the heart of education continues to be the holistic development of human beings. Qualities such as emotional resonance, value formation and creativity — elements that AI cannot replace — are the core qualities that teachers must cultivate to grow professionally.
